## Message from Your Event Chair

Dear Relayers,

As I write this article, the committee and staff have kicked into high gear heading toward April 18-19th. It is only 25 days away from Relay! Lots of exciting things are happening. Your 2008 committee has been working hard securing sponsorships, registering survivors, discussing the logistics behind the scenes, scheduling activities and entertainment—all trying to make sure that Relay For Life of Naples is bigger and better than ever.

When it comes to Sponsorships, we have had a few disappointments, which have lead us to look at things a little differently. As all of you know, the economy in Naples is in a downslide. As a result, we have seen the corporate sponsorship dollars shrink this year. We contacted additional companies and businesses, and offered them financially smaller ways to make a difference. We hope that many of them will soon accept our offer. We are also relying on the sale of Sunshine Signs by teams and the planning committee. We hope they will help fill the gap. If every team would sell 5 Sunshine Signs, that would generate over \$75,000 toward the bottom line. If your team sells a (new) sign, remember that \$150 of the \$175 paid gets credited to your team. If your team (re)sells an existing sign, your team

receives the entire \$175 credit. What a great way to bring in an extra \$750 or \$875! Please challenge your team members to find one business, friend or service who would like an inexpensive way to reach over 5,000 people in one night.

Our Survivor Committee is hard at work finding new ways to honor our Survivors. Over 1,000 letters and brochures have been sent out, with a goal of registering over 500 cancer Survivors to walk our opening lap this year. The committee is eager to register Survivors at your company, church, your fundraiser, or organization, so please contact us if you would like us to come and register Survivors. The Survivor Reception, hosted at and by Moorings Park, will be held on Sunday, March 30th at 1 pm. Space is limited so please RSVP to the ACS office if you are interested in attending. The committee has instituted an Adopt-a-Survivor program this year, to make sure that all Survivors have a tent site to call home. Cancer Survivors are our honored guests, and their caregivers will have an important role to play this year, too. We will invite the caregiver to walk the second lap of Relay with their Survivor, as well as at 8:45 p.m., prior to Luminaria, to receive their own accolades.

Amber Grider and Jamie Wenman have been busy lining up activities and



entertainment. Look for music, dancers, singers, games, theme laps, kids-specific activities, and fun for all ages to keep you busy for the entire 18 hours.

Teams having paid their registration fee prior to March 1 can reserve the same site as last year. All other teams will be allowed to pick their site based on the date they paid their registration fee.

We have had some technical difficulties with our web site, but national is busy trying to get things straightened out. Please be patient and try to get your team members registered. If you have problems, contact Sean at [relay@seankerwin.org](mailto:relay@seankerwin.org).

Relay For Life of Naples 2007 was the largest fundraising Relay in Florida. We are counting on each of you to help us make that happen in 2008. We will have almost 100 teams, helping raise over \$720,000 to fight against Cancer. I know that I can count on you.

## Why I Relay

It all started 45 years ago this past November for me. That was when I lost my father to Acute Leukemia. He was 32 years young. The following summer my two sisters and I, along with a few neighborhood friends, had a Carnival for Leukemia. We made about \$11 and were so proud. Our Mom sent a letter to the Leukemia Society along with the check. She also sent a thank you letter to the Editor of our local newspaper to be published, thanking our friends and neighbors. Eleven dollars may not seem like much, but remember this was 45 years ago and we sold candy and lemonade and played games for only pennies and nickels.

Ten months later my father's sister died of Ovarian Cancer, and two years later their Dad, my Grandpa, passed away from Leukemia. Since the 1960's, this dreadful disease has taken away many other family members, too many to mention here. Four years ago I became involved with the Relay For Life event. I have been a committee member of The District School Board, and this year I am the Chairperson for the Luminaria Ceremony.

I am asking all of you to join us at Relay For Life. Celebrate the lives of those touched by cancer, remember loved ones lost, and fight back against a disease that takes too much.

Please join in the activities on April 18th at Gulfview Middle School for a ceremony that will touch your life forever. I'll be in the Luminaria tent this year collecting donations and handing out the white Luminaria bags.

This year I will be at Relay because of my mother who presently has Leukemia, and my uncle who is battling Lung Cancer.

As always, thank you for all you do to support the American Cancer Society Relay For Life. With your help, we will bring an end to this disease.

## Eliminate the Phrase, *“You Have Cancer”*

Are you between the ages of 30 and 65? Do you want to help prevent cancer and be a part of finding the cure? If you have never been diagnosed with cancer, and are willing to make a long-term commitment, you can sign up to participate in the Cancer Prevention Study #3, being done by the American Cancer Society. Each Relay For Life participant who successfully donates blood from October 1, 2007 until May 12, 2008 will be eligible to receive a certificate redeemable for one (1) spirit chip. This certificate must be turned in to your Team Captain. Each Team Captain is responsible for getting all blood donor certificates turned in to the American Cancer Society office no later than May 11. Your donation will be verified and a spirit chip will be earned and counted automatically. For more information, please call Laura Rosen at 436-5303.

The Bloodmobile will be at Relay Friday night between 6-9:30 PM. If you are planning to donate blood, thank you! If you plan to donate blood AND be part of the Cancer Prevention Study #3, please **REGISTER WITH CPS-3 FIRST**, and then make your blood donation in the Bloodmobile.

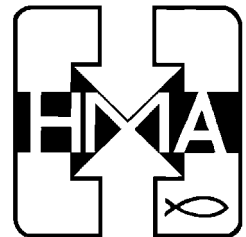

## Relay For Life of Naples—Event “Need-to-Knows!”

### CAMPSITE SET-UP & TEAR-DOWN

**NEW FOR 2008!** In order to protect the newly installed sod on the field, NO cars or trucks will be allowed on the field or track this year. Instead, “valet service” will be available for teams to get items to and from their campsites. Where else but Naples!

Items can be dropped off on Friday, between noon and 4 PM into a holding area at the main gate parking lot, and will be delivered to designated campsites via golf carts. Please have 2 team members, one to drive and one to stay with your items being delivered to your site. The same procedure will be used on Saturday beginning at 12:15 PM for tear-down.

### ON-SITE FUNDRAISING

Please e-mail your team’s on-site fundraisers to [oeldridge@cl-law.com](mailto:oeldridge@cl-law.com) by April 1, so they can be included in the event program at Relay. Program listings bring more customers!

### HANDICAP PARKING

A limited number of handicap parking spots will be available on the school property, by advanced reservation only, through the American Cancer Society office. Please call Ann at 261-0337, ext. 118. Passes are limited, and available on a first-come, first served basis. (*NOTE: Government-issued handicap stickers will not be valid for the special Relay handicap parking area.*)

### MOTORHOME PARKING

Motorhome parking will be available first come, first serve along the west side of 8th St S. ONLY, beginning Thursday night at 6 PM. Motorhomes parked elsewhere will be ticketed and/or removed by order of the City of Naples Police Dept.

### SURVIVOR PARKING

The Collier County Public Library parking lot (across from Gulfview Middle School) will be reserved for Survivor parking only. Additional parking will be available at the Kraft Construction site lot at 10th Street and 3rd Avenue South (the former Grand Central site).

### COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS AVAILABLE

Students can earn valuable service hours at Relay by helping the Event Committee hang signs, banners, fill coolers with ice and water bottles, empty trash bags, and less strenuous chores such as helping in Survivor Registration and other programs as needed. Help yourself with the hours, and help Relay with the extra hands and heart!

### TENT RENTALS SPECIAL DISCOUNT!

Give your team a respite from the elements by renting a tent for your site. A special discount has been arranged for all teams that rent from Creative Events, 597-8141. A 10x10 tent is \$164.55 and a 20x20 tent is \$289.61, plus sales tax. Price includes delivery, set-up, and take down (with no extra charges!) Team Captains must identify themselves as a Naples Relay team, and provide their site number at the time of rental to ensure receiving this special discount. (*Tables and chairs are also available at reduced rates.*)

### WRISTBANDS

Before the clock strikes 11:00 PM on Friday night, all children and youth UNDER 18, must be wearing Relay wristbands, or they’ll be asked to leave the event. Team Captains (only) are authorized to pick-up wristbands, beginning at 7:30 PM. Please bring a list of your UNDER 18 team members’ or guests’ names, along with a contact phone number for their responsible adult, to Command Central to get your wristbands. Please help us keep our youth safe, and make the event a safe and enjoyable family atmosphere.

### COMMAND CENTRAL

“**Information Central**”—that’s what Command Central is all about! Everything happens under the Command Central tent: Lost & Found, wristbands for children, team check-in, volunteer check-in, contest winner postings, 2009 Committee sign-ups, 2009 Team commitment forms, Advocacy information, Cancer Control, and the answers to questions like, “Where is the...,” “How do I...,” and “When is the...” and more!! See if you can stump the Command Central crew!

## And More...

### CAMPSITE JUDGING

Team campsites are judged by a volunteer group of Survivors based on the following criteria:

**Cancer Control/Advocacy** – an overall message that deals with cancer and prevention, or encourages good health

**Team Spirit** – team members are participating, and have a great attitude and spirit for the event

**Creativity/Originality** – incorporation of overall event theme

**Overall Appearance/Effect** – overall eye appeal, site design reflects time and effort by team

### EVENT DO'S AND DON'TS

- **YES:** Bring Friends, Family and Acquaintances
- **YES:** Have a great time and help raise money to find a cure for cancer
- **YES:** Enjoy the music, laughter, and entertainment, on and off the stage!
- **YES:** Plan to spend time visiting each team's campsite and support their effort
- **YES:** Help honor our special guests, the Survivors
- **NO:** Electrical cords or generators
- **NO:** Charcoal grills, candles or other open flames
- **NO:** Alcohol, and **NO** smoking
- **NO:** Animals (by order of City Park and School)
- **NO:** Balloons, confetti or silly string please!

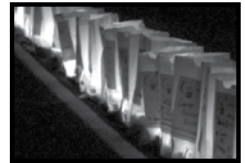
